As a requirement of the American Rescue Plan (ARP), each state and local education agency must provide descriptions and other information to address how they intend to use its ARP Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund allocation. This plan, crafted in consideration of feedback received via various stakeholder groups, is intended to meet the plan requirements set forth by the United States Department of Education.

Among other related activities, the Louisville Municipal School District intends to focus on (1) access to focused grade-level instruction and supports (including professional development, accommodations, modifications, tutorial services, and enrichment) to accelerate learning now and in future academic years; and (2) a stable, safe, encouraging, empathetic learning environment where students can openly share their unique experiences from the last year and can receive appropriate supports from counselors, teachers, and – if necessary – mental health professionals; and (3) facility improvements such as HVAC upgrades and touchless bathroom sensors.
